**Case Study**

- 1 A, being in dire need of money, sells his new car purchased two months ago at a cost of Rs. 1,72,000 for Rs. 11,000. Afterwards A seeks to set aside the contract on the ground of inadequacy of consideration. Will he succeed?
- 2 Over a cup of coffee in a restaurant, A invites B to a dinner at his house on a Sunday. B hires a taxi and reaches A's house at the appointed time, but A fails to perform his promise. Can B recover any damages from A?
- 3 M mows L's lawn without being asked by L to do so. L watches M do the work but does not attempt to stop him. Is L bound to pay any charges to M?
- 4 A promise to pay B Rs. 500 if B beats C. B beats C, but A refuses to pay. Can B recover the amount?
- 5 B offered to sell his house to A for Rs. 50,000. A accepted the offer by post. On the next day, A sent a telegram withdrawing the acceptance which reaches B before the letter.  
(a) is the revocation of acceptance valid?  
(b) would it make difference if both the letter communicating acceptance and the telegram communicating revocation of acceptance, reach B at the same time?

- 6 A made an offer to sell some goods to B conditional on receiving a reply by return of Post. A gave the letter to his peon to post but the peon forgot to post it immediately and actually posted it after seven days. On receiving A's letter, B wrote reply, accepting the offer and duly posted it by return of post. In the mean time, not having heard from B, A sold the goods to C. Has B any legal remedy against A?
- 7 A teaches his parrot to recite an offer and then sends the parrot to B. the bird repeats the recitation. Is this a valid offer?
- 8 D bought tyres from Dunlop Company and sold them to S, a sub dealer, who agreed with D not to sell below Dunlop's list price and to pay to Dunlop Company Rs. 75 as damages on every tyre he undersold. S sold two tyres at less than the list price and thereon Dunlop Company sued him for the breach. Will Dunlop company succeed?
