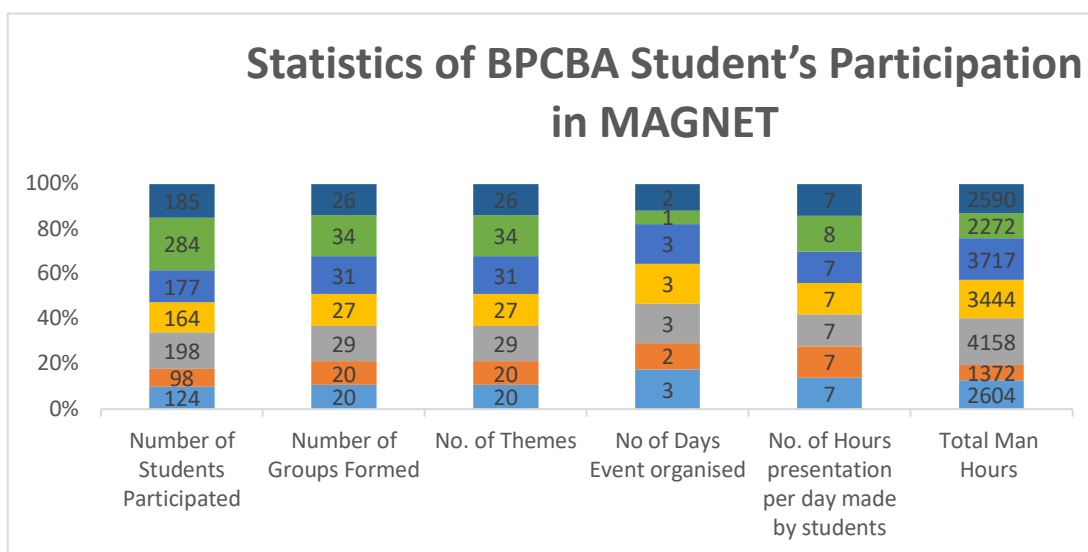
## *MAGNET*

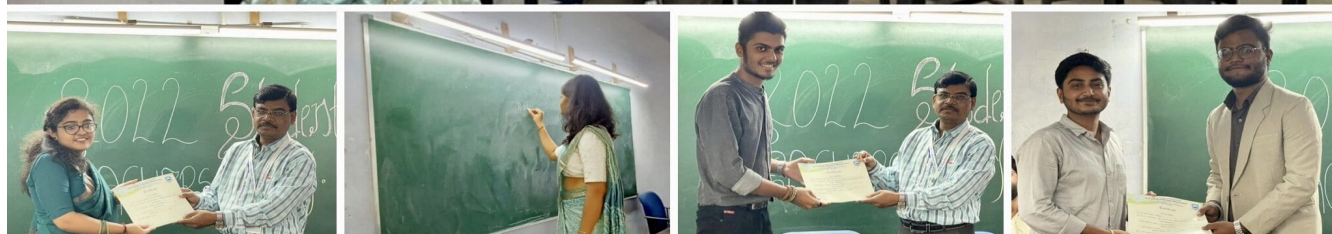
